

All CNC 4X4 Club sponsored trail rides **require** that the vehicles participating have the following:

Mandatory:

- Recovery Points (minimum of 1 front and rear)
- Fire Extinguisher
- Operational Seatbelts or Harness
- Secured Battery
- Factory Hardtop/Roof or Roll Bar
- Signed CNC 4x4 Waiver

Recommended:

- Tow Straps (no hooked or metal ends)
- Spare Tire (ideally full size or run flat)
- Jack and Lug wrench (appropriate for your vehicle size)
- Skid Plates
- CB Radio
- Basic Tool Kit
- Tire Pressure Gauge
- First Aid Kit
- Gloves
- Trash Bags
- Winch, Tree Saver, Snatch block

Suggested:

- Ice Chest/Cooler with Drinks & Food
- Toilet Paper & Baby Wipes
- Duct Tape
- Foul Weather Gear
- Tarp & Bungee Cords
- Camera
- Bug Repellant
- Extra Vehicle Fluids
- Radiator Stop Leak
- Full Tank of Fuel
- ICE Contact on Phone
- Hi-Lift Jack
- Tire Plug Kit
- Flash Light
